on June 21st 1943



This has given view to a new understanding of the components and functioning of the fibrinolytic system, and in respect of patients with acute myocardial infarction, has resulted in the development of a fibrin-specific thrombolytic therapy involving a tissue-type plasminogen activator.

It has, moreover, resolved to attach to this degree all present and future rights which by law or custom are or may be associated with the doctorate.



In testimony of which this charter is delivered to him, signed by the Rector Magnificus, the College of Deans and the promoters, and affirmed by the seal of the University.




